- It is also known as '**International Day for the Conservation of the Mangrove Ecosystem.**'
- It was first observed in 2015.

- These are **the Karikili Bird Sanctuary, Pallikaranai Marsh Reserve Forest and Pichavaram Mangrove in Tamil Nadu, the Sakhya Sagar in Madhya Pradesh and Pala Wetland in Mizoram.**
- There are now a total of **54 Ramsar sites** in the country.

- **Russia has decided** to quit the International Space Station (ISS) after 2024.
- Russia's space agency Roscosmos's new chief Yury Borisov announced this decision on 26 July 2022.
- ISS is a multinational collaborative project involving 5 participating space agencies: NASA (United States), Roscosmos (Russia), JAXA (Japan), ESA (Europe), & CSA (Canada).
- It has been **in Earth's orbit since 1998**.

- He treated people for just one rupee and is **fondly known as ‘Ek Takar Daktar’ (one rupee doctor)**.
- He treated patients for close to 60 years & in 2020 his name was recorded in the Guinness World Records for treating the maximum number of patients.
- He was also awarded **the Padma Shri in 2020**.
